## ABPANC SEEKS NOMINATIONS FOR PRESIDENT-ELECT

ABPANC is accepting nominations for its President-Elect position. The term of office is one (1) year, followed by a two (2) year term as President and one (1) year term as Immediate Past President. The individual elected as President-Elect would begin his/her term on July 1 2018. The ABPANC President-Elect may be CPAN, CAPA, or dually certified.

Why consider volunteering with ABPANC in this key leadership position?

As an ABPANC Volunteer, you have the unique opportunity at the national level to contribute to the development of the CPAN® and CAPA® certification programs that recognize and promote excellence in perianesthesia nursing practice and, most importantly, are in the best interest of perianesthesia patients and their families. As ABPANC President, you have the prestigious role of leading the Board of Directors as it deliberates on decisions that ultimately impact the quality of care delivered to perianesthesia patients.

Further, you have an opportunity to:

- as nurses, give back to a profession that you've built a career on;
- ensure the quality of care delivered and make a positive difference in patient outcomes;
- influence national standards and practice;
- advocate for perianesthesia patients and their loved ones at a *global* level beyond your immediate environment;
- grow professionally in areas you're not exposed to every day;
- network nationally with colleagues beyond the walls of your own workplace;
- be recognized as a *national* leader within your profession; and
- collaborate with other national professional organizations and their leaders.

Nominees must express a commitment to the perianesthesia nursing specialty and to professional certification. You must view specialty nursing certification as a means for public protection and be committed to professional certification as a means of validating the knowledge, skills and abilities required to practice perianesthesia nursing in order to promote quality patient care. The ability to understand issues related to certification from a *global* perspective is key.

In addition to excellent verbal, written, and interpersonal skills, being computer literate and having access to a computer and the internet, and confidence as a public speaker, nominees must exhibit the following competencies (as described in ABPANC's *Nominations Handbook and Application* – please note that if a nominee for this office is not a current member of the ABPANC Board of Directors, he/she must also demonstrate the competencies for a Director as well – refer to the *Nominations Handbook and Application* for a listing of *Director* competencies):

- Achievement Orientation
- Developing Others
- Flexibility

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- Impact and Influence
- Self Confidence
- Team Leadership
